3.3.1 Code of Practice for Parents/Guardians/Carers

Club Name:- Chatsworth Tennis Club

- Encourage your child to learn the rules of tennis and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Allow your children to play in the Mini Tennis colour stage that is appropriate to them. This will ensure they will enjoy playing the game and gain confidence.
- Purchase balls and rackets, which match the stage that your child is in.
- Be patient. Children will rarely progress steadily, but more often progress in peaks and plateaux.
- Your first question following your child's match should be – "Did you enjoy it?" not "Did you win?"
- At no stage should you communicate with your child or interfere with the on court helpers/referees during a match – this often makes things worse!

Code of Practice for Young People Aged 13 to 17

Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the Club Manager.

As a member of Chatsworth Tennis Club, you are expected to abide by the following junior code of practice:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background or religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
